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**CAMP RULES, CODE OF CONDUCT, AND CONTRACT**

ATTENDANCE

- A. Camp participants are expected to attend and participate in each planned activity.
- B. Punctual attendance is expected of all participants. Tardiness and absenteeism will not be tolerated and may lead to suspension from the program.

CODE OF CONDUCT

The camp director and Magnolia Bar Foundation will not tolerate any camp participant engaging in any behavior that is not in his best interest or in the best interest of the Program. The Foundation will also hold camp participants responsible for good behavior during all activities, both on campus and away from campus.

Disorderly conduct or misconduct, includes but is not limited to the following:

- 1. Voluntary/unauthorized absence from activities
- 2. Leaving the camp without permission
- 3. Smoking on college property or other camp locations
- 4. Fighting or provoking a fight
- 5. Weapons in your possession (on or off campus)
- 6. Possessions of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs
- 7. Disruption of Program Activities
- 8. Vulgarity, profanity and obscenity
- 9. Disregard for constituted authority (camp director/workshop leader)
- 10. Theft
- 11. Harassment, intimidation or threats
- 12. Destruction of college premises
- 13. Leaving an activity, program or meetings without permission
- 14. Possession or use of fireworks
- 15. Belongings may be searched by residential coordinator at his/her discretion.
